WHEREAS, the Borough of Kulpmont shall comply and follow a plan of citizen participation through various notices, press releases, comment periods, and public hearings for the purpose of receiving input from the public for Borough-wide Competitive Community and Housing Development activities; and

WHEREAS, the PA Department of Community and Economic Development DCED, Office of Community Housing Development OCHD requires perspective non-entitlement Community Development Block Grantees to comply and provide with a local management plan that has adequate capacity to administer community and affordable housing assistance activities; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Kulpmont is desirous of applying for Community and Affordable Housing Development funding Assistance through the Community Development Block Grant CDBG Competitive Program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Kulpmont Council authorizes the proper officials to apply for a FFY 2004 Competitive Community Development Block Grant in the amount of \$500,000, and to provide a local management plan to administer said funding assistance with Technical Assistance from the Housing Development Corporation of Northumberland County.

WHEREAS, The PA Department of Community and Economic Development DCED, Office of Community and Housing Development OCHD "GRANTOR", is currently soliciting Federal Funding Year FFY 2004 Competitive Community Development Block Grant assistance requests pursuant to the Housing and Community Development Act 179 of 1974 as amended in accordance with Section 105(a) "ACT"; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Kulpmont, Northumberland County, a non-entitlement community 'CDBG APPLICANT' is eligible for FFY2004 Competitive CDBG funding assistance pursuant to said ACT is desirous of submitting an application for said program assistance; and

WHEREAS, the GRANTOR requires the CDBG APPLICANT to provide a plan for: citizen participation through notices, comment periods, and public hearings; local management to address the need for adequate capacity to administer community and affordable housing activities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Borough of Kulpmont Council is authorizing the filing of an Application by the proper officials in the amount of \$500,000 for funding assistance with the PA Department of Community and Economic Development DCED, Office of Community and Housing Development OCHD.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough of Kulpmont will administer said funding assistance with technical assistance from the Housing Development Corporation of Northumberland County HDCNC.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appropriate officer of the Borough of Kulpmont Council is directed to execute a certificate attesting to the adoption of this Resolution and to furnish a copy of this Resolution to DCED.
