

**RESOLUTION #646**

**LED Traffic Signal Conversion Project  
Borough of Kulpmont**

**WHEREAS**, LED (light emitting diode) traffic light technology reduces the amount of electricity use by 85 to 90%; and

**WHEREAS**, LED lights represent a significant annual decrease in electricity cost; and

**WHEREAS**, SEDA-Council of Governments, in partnership with PennDOT, is providing technical assistance to counties and their municipalities to bulk purchase and install LED traffic light technology through the LED Traffic Signal Conversion Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the LED equipment will be acquired through one bulk purchase agreement with a PennDOT approved vendor on behalf of a consortium of municipalities participating in this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the county may serve as the procurement agent on behalf of their municipalities participating in the consortium; and

**WHEREAS**, SEDA-COG has procured grant funding to reduce the costs for participating municipalities to purchase the LED traffic lights; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Kulpmont has determined that it is in the best interest of Kulpmont to participate in the LED Traffic Signal Conversion Project,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Borough of Kulpmont desires to purchase and install LED traffic signals through participation in the LED Traffic Signal Conversion Project.
