

RESOLUTION #649

Borough of Kulpmont, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF KULPMONT TO COMMIT TO PARTICIPATE IN A PEER TO PEER TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, representatives from the municipalities within the Mount Carmel Area School District and Shamokin Area School District, and PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources met to discuss the possible creation of a joint regional recreation committee; and

WHEREAS, the proposed recreational commission would provide recreational opportunities for the residents of participating municipalities or parts thereof which make up the school districts of Mount Carmel and Shamokin and other adjacent areas; and

WHEREAS, DCNR has grant funds available requiring a 10% match for the preparation of a Regional Recreation Study to be prepared as a Peer to Peer Technical Assistance Project; and

WHEREAS, Kulpmont Borough, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania desires to participate in the preparation of the aforementioned Regional Recreation Study; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Kulpmont Borough, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

1. Kulpmont Borough hereby approves an expenditure of up to Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) to assist in meeting the grant requirements of the local match of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to be joined with a Ten Thousand Dollar (\$10,000.00) grant.
2. Kulpmont Borough hereby authorizes and directs Mount Carmel Township to be the lead applicant for the Regional Recreation Study grant.
3. Kulpmont Borough will appoint one elected official and one at large citizen to the advisory group which will assist DCNR in preparing the study and that in the event there is difficulty in providing this representation, the Kulpmont Borough Secretary is authorized to attend.
4. Kulpmont Borough hereby offers its assistance to Mount Carmel Township in writing the grant.
